Eligibility Criteria

To apply for the CIX Startup Awards, your company must:

- Be an incorporated business in Canada
- Be headquartered in Canada

- Be privately held and not listed on any exchanges anywhere in the world
- Have a unique/disruptive/innovative digitally-based business that brings commercial or social value
- Have a functional prototype (at minimum) of the product, service or application (must be in market, can be pre-revenue)
- In addition to rating your company's innovation, market opportunity, management and business model, the judges will rate your company on its diversity of leadership
- The company CEO or Founder must be available to present at the CIX Summit, in-person, March 25-26, 2025 in downtown Toronto

We recommend that your submission include a Pitch Deck or Sales Deck in PDF format.

Note: It's important to distinguish startups from other business models. A consultancy company, for instance, does not fall under the startup category. Startups are not simply about providing services; they are about creating and leveraging technology to build scalable products or solutions that can have a broad and lasting impact.

If your company was previously a CIX award recipient in an Early-stage category, you may apply again and we will consider you in the Growth category.

The Judging Process

The Selection Committee evaluates each application on the following six criteria:

Business Model

- Quality of Product and Service Offering
- Innovation
- Market Opportunity
- Depth of Management
- Diversity, Equity and Inclusion of Leadership
